Innovate UK KTN helps shape the future of sustainable protein

- Insect protein has the potential to help address key global challenges.
- We helped bring together leading UK companies to develop a collaborative funding bid, with the potential to transform the insect protein sector in the UK.
- 15 organisations came together to accelerate the development of cutting-edge technology to upcycle food waste into animal feed, using black soldier fly.







Innovate UK KTN helps shape the future of sustainable protein

- The funding bid was awarded £5.9m Innovate UK funding as part of a £9.8m project.
- By 2040, the project aims to have created 3300 UK based jobs.
- It plans to generate annual revenues of £400m for UK tax paying businesses.
- It plans to deliver savings of 50m tonnes CO2 equivalent, driving the industry closer to net zero emissions.


